Spares or repair

No public-road use until safe and legal

Do not drive a salvage or repaired vehicle on a public road unless its category permits road use, any necessary repairs have been completed, a competent person has assessed it as safe and roadworthy, and all applicable legal requirements are met.

History and category

The listing's category, history, mileage and other details do not replace the seller's accurate description or the buyer's own checks. A vehicle shown as unrecorded may later be recorded; its status is not guaranteed to remain unchanged.

Independent checks

Before agreeing to buy, the buyer should check the vehicle's identity, VIN, finance, theft and write-off history, MOT record, condition and suitability. salvage.direct recommends an independent vehicle history check and the official MOT history service at gov.uk/check-mot-history.

Warranty and returns

The seller gives no additional voluntary warranty or change-of-mind returns policy unless written in Notes on page 1. No refund is due merely because the buyer changes their mind or because of a fault clearly disclosed before sale. Nothing in this form removes rights or remedies that the law does not allow the seller to exclude, including applicable consumer rights where the seller is a trader.
