4 CONDITION, CHECKS AND LEGAL POSITION

Salvage condition

The vehicle is offered as salvage and/or for spares or repair. It may have known and unknown faults, missing parts or damage. The defects recorded on page 1 form part of its description.

Running is not roadworthy

A description such as "runs", "starts" or "drives" describes only the observed condition for loading or movement. It does not mean the vehicle is safe or legal for use on public roads. Arrange a thorough inspection and any necessary repairs before driving it.

History and category

Any insurance category, history, mileage or other data on the listing is a guide and must not replace the seller's accurate description or the buyer's own checks. A vehicle currently shown as unrecorded may later be recorded. No one promises that its status will stay unchanged.

Independent checks

The buyer should check identity, VIN, finance, theft, write-off history and MOT information before purchase. Salvage.Direct recommends an independent vehicle history check, for example at totalcarcheck.co.uk, and the official MOT history service at gov.uk/check-mot-history.

Warranty and returns

The seller gives no additional voluntary warranty or change-of-mind returns policy unless written on page 1. No refund is due merely because the buyer changes their mind or because of a fault clearly disclosed before sale. Nothing in this form removes rights or remedies that the law does not allow the seller to exclude, including applicable consumer rights where the seller is a trader.

Platform role

The seller and buyer are responsible for their transaction.
